- 1. HISTORY: US History or US History in Spanish

 Program must be fluent in Spanish and pass a Language assessment)
- 2. ENGLISH: English 8 or Advanced English 8
 Students whose parents request, 7th grade teacher recommends, and are willing to work hard can request Advanced English 8.
- 3. MATH: Math or Accelerated Math 8
 Students whose parents request, 7th grade teacher recommends, and are willing to work hard can request Accelerated Math.

ZERO Period

Allows students to take 2 electives.

Starts at 7:30 am (1 hour before the rest of the school)

Only select if you can commit and can make it to school early. Students will not be dropped once placed in it.

Student and Parent/Guardian must sign a <u>contract</u> stating that they understand what is involved when taking a zero period and must make the commitment to attend, be on time daily, and will not be able to drop the class once the commitment is made.

Zero Period classes will only be offered if enough students select this option.
